

Disappearing Frogs Project

Goal:

To create an installation of sound/imagery and text that brings attention to the disappearance of frogs/amphibians. Many species have already become extinct. Close to 3000 species face the prospect of extinction during our lifetime.

They serve as the proverbial canary in the mineshaft. Artists can help to change this by bringing attention to this issue.

Call for artists:

Paint-print-draw-sculpt-design! On one or more 4 x 4 inch paper or fabric surfaces create your interpretation of the frog. Sign the front and on the back of the image, write your name, phone number, email and return address.

Why?

- To be displayed as part of an international multi-media installation that brings attention to the disappearance of our frog species worldwide.
- Images will be displayed over several months/years in different cities/countries in order to stimulate a dialogue and create awareness.
- The images will ultimately be sold or returned to the artist if requested. Some or all images may be used to create a publication to raise funds and artists will be acknowledged appropriately. The proceeds will go to non-profits that have shown a consistent commitment to education and activism regarding clean air and water issues.

When?

- For the first exhibit that will take place in the Summer of 2013 send in your original frogs to the address below no later than May 30th.
